MISSION OF THE MONTH-CASS RIVER PET FRIENDZ

The Mission Committee would like to collect donations to Cass River Pet Friendz, during the month of July.

This volunteer organization has been helping pets and their guardians in Tuscola County, for 25 year. The money that is donated goes directly to helping those animals in need. CRPF is a 501c registered non-profit organization.

They have spent \$965,753, nearly a million dollars to date, helping animals and their owners. 4,600+ dogs and 5,723+ cats have found new homes. CRPF help in the adoption of pets in our area. They assist in spay and neuter of pets. The last few years they joined with Tuscola Area Animal Shelter in taking feral and barn cats down to the Flint program, to be spayed or neutered. A limited amount of veterinary financial assistance is also offer. They also offer help to low income residents. CRPF's mission is to end pet overpopulation in Tuscola County.

There are several ways that you can join in the fight to stop pet overpopulations in our area. Join in on the 5 Buck Friday fundraiser on Facebook. Become a monthly subscriber, automatic by visiting www.petfriendz.org. Donate your Pop n Bottles to the fundraiser or contact Lynne Whalen on FB. AUGUST MONTHLY OFFERING-IMAGINATION LIBRARY

Since launching in 1995, Dolly Parton's Imagination Library has become the preeminent early childhood book-gifting program in the world. The flagship program of The Dollywood Foundation, a 501c non-profit organization, has gifted nearly 200 million free books in the United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Australia and the Republic of Ireland.

The Imagination Library mails more than 2 million high-quality, age-appropriate books each month, to enrolled children from birth to age five. One in ten children in the USA receive a book from Dolly each month. Dolly envisioned creating a lifelong love of reading and inspiring children to dream more, learn more, care more and be more.

Dolly Parton came from very humble beginnings in a one bedroom cabin in rural Tennessee. Her father was sharecropper who couldn't read. They had 14 people living in the small cabin, with very limited resources. Dolly has written about how this has influenced her to help others, especially in literacy. She established her foundation locally in 1988 to decrease the dropout rate. It blossomed from there to become a statewide, nationwide and now has expanded globally. Dolly Parton spends much of her income on philanthropy efforts, focusing on education, health and disaster relief.

The impact of the program has been widely researched and results suggest positive increases in key early childhood literacy metrics. Through the unique partnerships among The Foundation, the publisher, the fulfillment centers and thousands of Local Program Partners this continues to be a reward winning reading program globally. We hope that you will join us in donating to Dolly Parton's dream of ending illiteracy and creating a better life for children today and in the future.
