



Good Samaritan Ornament Sale

It's that time of year again! Time to purchase your Food Bank of Eastern Michigan holiday ornament. Good Samaritan volunteers will be selling a new style of ornament this year to support the Good Samaritan Food Pantry which is housed in our church.

The food pantry is open Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9-noon year-round. During the first nine months of 2024 we supplied 1,396 Tuscola County families with 3-day supplies of food for a total of 66,824 pounds.

Most of our food is purchased from the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan. Any money we raise selling ornaments in November and December goes directly into our account to help pay for our orders. Currently we are ordering around \$2,000 worth of food every two weeks.




Operation Christmas Child


